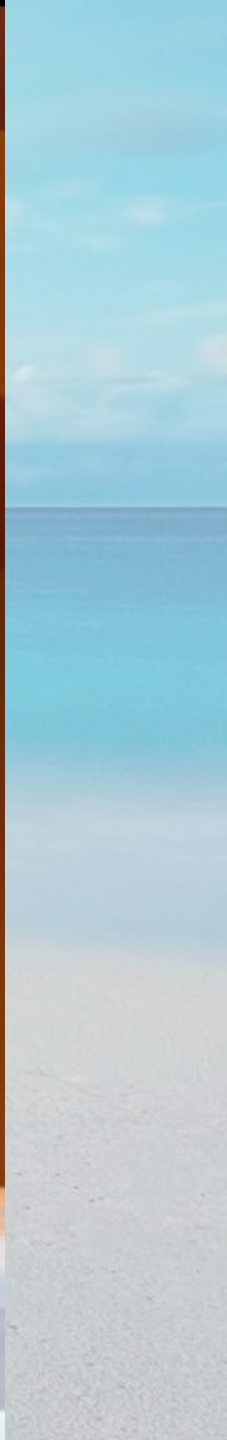

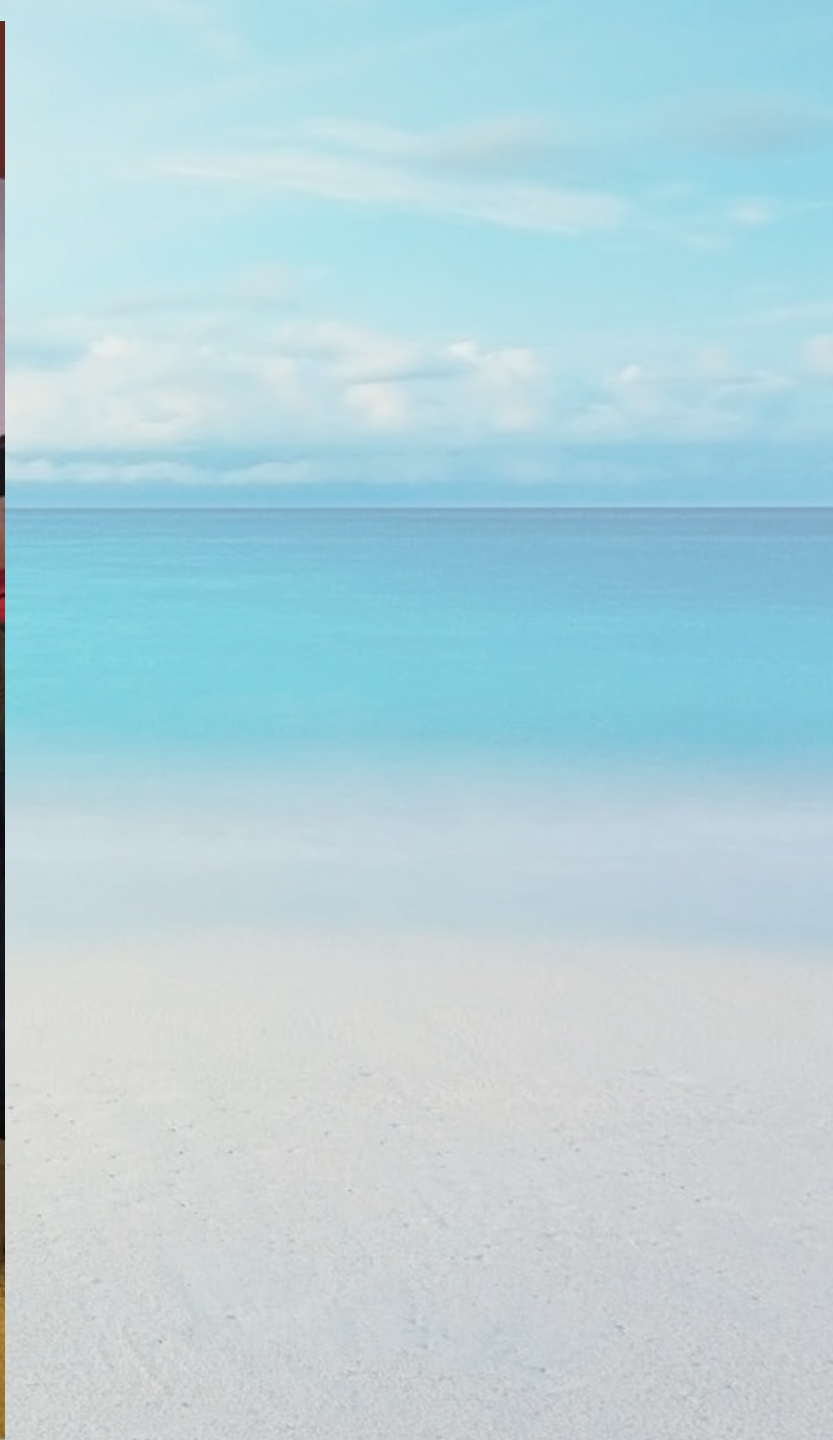

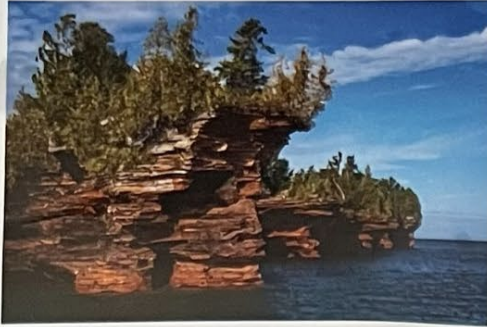

F/A-18A++ Hornet



Fighter Attack Squadron 112 (VFMA-112) is a reserve United States Marine Corps McDonnell Douglas F/A-18 Hornet squadron. The squadron is based at NASASB, Fort Worth, Texas and falls under the command of Marine Aircraft Group 41 (MAG-41), 4th Marine Aircraft Wing (4th MAW). Their tail code is MA. During World War II the squadron was active throughout the Pacific Theater of Operations especially at the Battle of Guadalcanal as part of the Carrier Battle Force. By the end of the war, 140 air-to-air kills ranked it third among Marine Corps squadrons.

Between WWII and the 2000s, the squadron flew the F4U Corsair but eventually flew the F-9 Panther, the A1-ZE Fury and the F-101 Super Sabre.

In 2002, VFMA-112 transitioned to the F/A-18A++ aircraft. The squadron was the first Reserve squadron to deploy on a Westcoast exercise since the Korean War. In the summer of 2006, the squadron supported Operation Eagle Shield and Exercise Southern Cross while operating out of Japan, Guam and Australia. In 2005, VFMA-112 deployed to Orléans Mable Air Station, Norway, for the international exercise Battle Griffin. The exercise was conducted to enhance cohesive operations between multinational forces and hone air-to-ground combat skills. The Marines experienced cold weather and harsh conditions during the exercise.

VFMA-112 has been working closely with sister squadron MAG-24 on what has been called the "Hornet/Griffin Expeditionary Package". The conceptual program would allow an F/A-18A++ to land on hastily constructed runways and refuel and rearm quickly without needing to return to base, as is the current operating procedure. The program would be in keeping with the Marine Corps nature of self-sufficiency. The squadron was deployed to Al Asad Air Base, Al Anbar Province, Iraq in late 2003. During their deployment, the Cowboys supported the ground withdrawal from the major cities in Iraq, supporting the US Marine Corps during numerous missions, and provided key aerial surveillance intelligence. The squadron was the first fighter/squadron to receive the 1st Air Force's new F/A-18A++ version A. The F/A-18A++ version A is the equivalent of the F/A-18C version. As a result of plans to replace the F/A-18A++ operationally with the US Navy's F/A-18E/F Super Hornet, the F/A-18A++ is being phased out. Native Texans Bill Neale and Carroll Shelby met in the 1950's at the Caddo Mills race track. As former WWII aviators, the pair quickly became close sharing their love of fast cars and dirt bikes. As Shelby said, "We hit it off. We lied to each other all afternoon. He likes to tell people that our relationship has naturally matured over the years." During the raucous, no holds barred era of the nineteen-sixties, Neale and Shelby, along with other Shelby Rat Packers - Dave Witts, Tom Tierney and David E. Davis, would unwind hunting, racing dirt bikes and - God knows what else - at a dusty and deserted town called Terlingua on the Texas Gulf coast.

36th Infantry Division

The 36th Infantry Division was created in 1917 and first saw combat in World War I. During World War II its amphibious assault at Salerno, Italy made it the first American division to land on the continent of Europe. After bloody battles to take San Pietro and cross the Rapido River, the 36th led the breakout from Anzio and became the first Allied unit to pass through Rome.

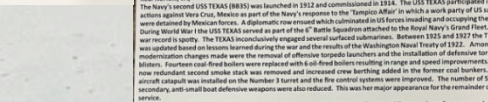
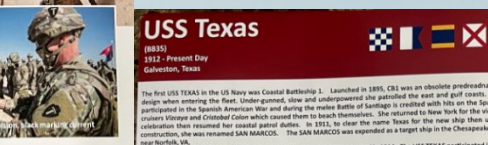
The division helped spearhead the invasion of Southern France and fought its way through the Siegfried Line into Germany and Austria. Throughout the Cold War the Fighting 36th manned the ramparts of freedom, keeping a constant vigil until the communist threat collapsed. From peace keeping missions in the Balkans and Kosovo to numerous overseas deployments in support of Operations New Dawn, Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, and most recently Spartan Shield the 36th Infantry Division has continuously played an historic and vital role in America's defense.

In addition, it has come to the aid of fellow Texans during numerous major hurricanes, various other natural disasters, border security and civil disturbance operations, and has helped vaccinate over twenty six million Texans against COVID-19. Since World War I the 36th Infantry Division has continued to prove its ability to safeguard the freedoms and livelihoods of all Americans at home and abroad.

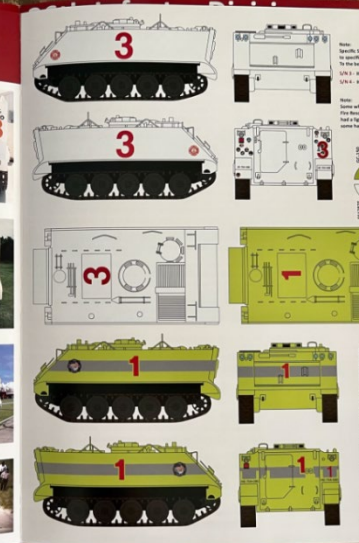

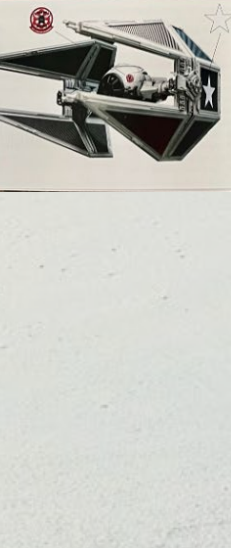
Sci-Fi TIE Interceptor

"What-If" Markings
181st Fighter Squadron
Texas ANG "Dusters"

The TIE Interceptor was a type of TIE fighter used by the Galactic Empire, most notably during the Battle of Endor. The Interceptor was identifiable by the addition of four arrow-shaped panels tipped with laser cannons. They were nicknamed "Squints" due to their narrow shape.

These "What-If" markings are a historical play off the actual 181st Fighter Squadron from Post WWII. The solar panels of the TIE Interceptor are painted a Red/White/Blue pattern like the Texas Flag with a fictitious Texas ANG Dusters squadron patch.

Thanks to Rob Booth who discovered this squadron patch while he was researching a TX ANG group build for the 2023 Nats. Have fun with it! Decals are sized for the MPC TIE Interceptor kit.
